## Tennis Court Rules

## October 2023

The tennis court is for the exclusive use of Unit Owners, Residents, and their guests. If guests of Unit Owners, Residents, or dependent children (under 12 years of age) are to use the tennis court, the Unit Owner or Adult Resident must be present during such use. At no time is the number of guests of the Unit Owner or Resident to exceed four. (Any non-resident will be considered a guest).

- Pets are not allowed on the tennis courts.
- Playing longer than one hour is permitted only if no one is waiting.
- Hard-soled shoes are prohibited. Rubber/soft sole (Tennis) shoes must be worn by all players. The use of regulation tennis wear is encouraged.
- The tennis court is for tennis or pickleball only. It is not to be used as a playground or for other sports. Swinging, hanging, or leaning on the net is forbidden.
- Refuse, such as gum wrappings, ball cans, etc., are to be removed by individuals using the court.
- The gate must be kept locked at all times.
